## 1 WFF program introduction

WFF program - an international environmental education, and award program, created to organize and conduct expeditions in radio specially protected natural areas in order to attract world attention to the problems of protected areas, providing them with real and practical help in the wake the minds of the inhabitants of Planet Earth sense of pride in the natural and cultural heritage, as well as educational and conservation purposes.

WFF program was established in July 2008 and was timed to coincide with the UN declared the International Year of Planet Earth. UN General Assembly declared 2008 the International Year of Planet Earth. In its resolution that "the Year could play a decisive role, particularly in raising public awareness about the importance of sustainable development processes taking place on the Earth and the rational exploitation of its resources, disaster prevention, reduction of poverty and mitigation, capacity building resource management and that it will make an important contribution to the Decade of Education for Sustainable Development United Nations."

The General Assembly encouraged all Member States, the United Nations and all other parties to use the Year to increase awareness of the importance of earth sciences for sustainable development and to stimulate action for nature conservation at the local, national, regional and international levels, different countries.

Protected areas - a land, water surface and air space above them, which are natural complexes and objects that have special environmental, scientific,

cultural, aesthetic, recreational and curative value. These territories seized by a public authority wholly or partly of economic use for them have been afforded special protection.

Protected areas are sites of national heritage.

Federal laws of all countries that have specially protected natural areas, regulate relations in the organization, protection and use of protected areas to preserve the unique and typical natural complexes and objects, remarkable natural formations, flora and fauna, their gene pool, studies natural processes in the biosphere and monitoring the change in its status, the environmental education of the population.

According to many scientists, one of the most valuable natural resources in the XXI century. will be kept pristine wilderness areas. They maintained the integrity of natural systems necessary to maintain the ecological balance on Earth. They directly affect the quality of life, are a source of clean water and clean air. The word "health" is associated wonder with wildlife, and we have in mind the nature not covered destructive economic activity and protected in nature reserves, national parks and other protected areas. The number of these areas should steadily expand, if we do not want to lose the most important condition for ensuring the quality of life - clean and safe for the human environment.

WFF Foundation adheres to the treatment of protected areas developed by the World Conservation Union (IUCN) and the following classifications of protected natural areas:

- a) Strict Nature Reserve (Strict Nature Reserve) - strict protection in conjunction with the study area;
- b) Territory Wildlife (Wilderness Area) - strict protection with little or no site visit;
- c) National Park or Nature Park (National Park, Nature Park) - the conservation of ecosystems in the public access to some areas for recreational purposes;
- d) Nature Monument (Natural Monument) - save some natural objects (WFF reference issued in exceptional cases);
- e) Territory control species or habitats (Habitat / Species Management Area) - the conservation of ecosystems and individual species through active management, including in the process of nature;
- f) Protected Landscape (Protected Landscape / Seascape) - maintenance of land or coastal landscapes in the environmental and recreational purposes;
- g) The managed resource area (Managed Resource Protected Area) - Sustainable use of natural resources.

## 2 WFF program management

Note 1

- 2.1 WFF Guide Foundation is the governing body of the WFF program.
- 2.2 The head of the WFF program forms the WFF Committee of protected areas and is its chairman.
- 2.3 The head of the WFF program is part of the WFF Executive Committee and approved by the Fund Management of the WFF.
- 2.4 The head of the WFF program is guided according to the position of official duties. The position operates the calendar year with subsequent prolongation.
- 2.5 Solution Guide WFF Foundation to appoint the head of the WFF program and chairman of the Committee WFF protected areas appear on the site WFF Foundation.

## 3 Officials, authorized representatives and WFF Coordinators

- 3.1 Management of the Fund with the participation of WFF Committee of Protected Areas shall designate and approve the official and authorized representatives of the WFF program in the world, who are appointed from among volunteer active volunteers.
- 3.2 Management of the Fund with the participation of WFF Committee of Protected Areas shall designate and approve the WFF program coordinators in the countries of the world, who are appointed from among volunteer active volunteers.
- 3.3 The National Representatives, Program Coordinators and National Award Manager represent the WFF program in the country, carry out coordination of the program, determine the order of activation of the territories listed in the Directory WFF, as well as address issues of accreditation of the protected areas of the country.

## 5 **WFF directory**

List of references WFF program is presented in the current edition of WFF Directory. It includes specially protected natural areas in most countries of the world. Each territory is assigned a unique alphanumeric identification code that indicates membership in a particular country or territory of the world and the serial number of the references, for example:

- China: BYFF-154 Wuyishan Biosphere reserve
- Germany DLFF-024 Flusslandschaft Elbe Biosphere reserve
- Spain EAFF-019 Sierra de Grazalema Biosphere reserve

etc., corresponding to a protected natural area in the world classification of the WFF program.

The list of references in the WFF Directory is not final and may be changed as

interest clubs, organizations or individual resident amateurs who are willing to provide to the WFF Committee request that includes accurate and competent materials on the existing protected areas, with links to the main source of the Ministries or State other specialized organizations.

- 5.1 Adding new areas in the WFF directory and editing the existing list is in the immediate competence of the WFF References Manager.

Term of consideration of each request, the application for assignment of WFF NEW ONE is considered up to 2 weeks after the filing of the application. The results of the inquiry, the application can be found at the protocols of official inquiries and requests the Secretariat WFF Foundation:

- 5.2 Consideration of expanding the national list of references is WFF Committee only if the following conditions:

5.2.1 50%, 75% , 90% activated rule

- a) When 50% of National WFF areas have been activated, it is possible to assign up to a maximum of 50 new WFF references.
- b) When 75% of National WFF areas have been activated, it is possible to assign up to a maximum of 75 new WFF references.
- c) When 90% of National WFF areas have been activated, it is possible to assign up to a maximum of 90 new WFF references.

For a maximum of two times every year for each Country

- 5.2.2 Only the National Coordinator can assign the new references (through the WFF References Manager).

- 5.2.3 If a country do not have WFF representation, the WFF References Manager can assign the new references.

- 5.2.4 New WFF references are to be allocated according to following guidelines, starting with class A, and when all are included in the directory to start with Class B.

- b) Natural Park
- c) Regional Park
- d) Protected Natural Area
- e) Natural Reserve
- f) Regional Reserve
- g) Naturalistic Oasis
- h) Biosphere Reserve or Biotope

- ab) Special Area Protection established by Europe governments
- ac) Others to define (Landscape Restricted Areas, FFH-Areas (Flora/Fauna Habitat))

5.2.6 New references shall be valid for WFF *EITHER* retrospectively to the date of eligibility *OR* from the date of inclusion in the WFF Directory.

## 6 Terms of activation of WFF areas

When the words “activation” and activity are to be read as “activation of one WFF area”.

6.1 While working within a protected area included in the list of the WFF program, all equipment (antennas, transceiver, power supply ect.) must be within the boundaries of the territory. Activators must fully comply with the requirements of administration and rules of conduct for this protected area.

6.2 Activity is allowed only under an identifier (WFF reference) Is not allowed to work under the identifiers of two or more protected areas at a time.

6.3 In the case where the working position is within a WFF reference (eg a Nature Reserve), located within a larger protected area (National Park, Nature Park) is  
a) the activation of the small internal location is under the reference of the smaller location only.  
b) For the subsequent activation of the outer protected area the operating position must be moved outside the inner WFF references, but remain within the outer larger protected area

6.4 In general the least number of QSO has to be 44 without band limitation, for an activation to count for a WFF activator award. (National rules may set other requirements for National awards). An activator can accumulate the number of QSO's with multiple activations of the same WFF to count for a activator award.

6.5 All QSO's are valid for hunters, regardless of the number for QSO's made in the activation.

6.6 When the serial activation of several WFF references (complex WFF expedition) under one call sign, starting with the next protected area may be no earlier than 5 hours after the start of activity in the air from the previous area.

6.7 With the serial activation of several WFF references, it is not allowed to activate more than 2 activations in the same day under one call sign.

6.8 Each activation must have a duration more than 2 hours.

6.9 When activating, marine parks and areas where the security zone is only natural water area, all equipment must be kept on board ship or on a coastal area located within 100 meters from the edge of protected water surface.

6.10 “/ AM” activity on board of any aircraft (airplane, helicopter, glider, glider, balloon, blimp, etc.), located above a protected natural area is not allowed in the WFF program with the.

## **7 Accreditation of WFF activity**

- 7.1 For the accreditation of the territory included in the WFF Directory, you must provide documentary material or copies, confirming the activity of a protected area: the input and approvals for the right to visit the protected area, travel documents, call the expedition, call participants. Additionally provided photo / video materials, samples of QSL-cards, GPS data, etc.
- 7.2 Prior to the activation of a WFF area not previously activated (WFF NEW ONE), a mandatory announcement of not less than three days before the activity is required consistent with the national or official representative of the WFF program coordinator of the country in which the given WFF reference. In the absence of representatives of national coordination of this is made directly with the WFF Committee. This condition, in addition to clarifying and harmonizing the conditions necessary to activate the protected area, will allow time to place the information on the activity of the majority of information resources, covering the activities of the WFF program and to inform about the upcoming event, the bulk of the WFF program participants.
- 7.3 The expedition must provide an electronic log file in ADIF format.
- 7.4 The log in ADIF format along with documentation are to be send to:
- a) In countries with national WFF representation the national award manager
  - b) In countries with out national WFF representation the WFF Approval Operations Manager

## **8 Green log search**

Green Log Search Service provides data on the QSO on the basis of the log WFF expeditions, as well as residents, carrying out the work of the protected areas, and is designed to produce statistical information and registration applications for the WFF diplomas and awards in the online radio amateurs around the world.

After submitting the application to the WFF Graduation Committee, in your e-mail, indicated on this form will be sent to set up Green Log Search copy of the application, payment terms and details of qualifications diploma WFF Committee. The head of the WFF program processes the request and informs the applicant numbers and classes of certificates and awards, which, in turn, will be sent after payment WFF Graduation Committee. WFF Committee Protected Areas recommends that at the end of WFF expedition, radio stations, which count for the WFF program, provide a e-Log in ADIF format for Green Log Search, which will save time and money on drawing up applications for hand-WFF diplomas and awards for applicants, and well as diplomas and awards of national programs in a series of WFF.

## 9 WFF network - creating a national diploma program of protected areas

Fund WFF Committee with the participation of protected areas is developing WFF Network (WFF network) and welcomes the creation and establishment of national award program of specially protected natural areas. First of all, suggestions discussed with the recommendations of the current national amateur radio organizations around the world, if they, in turn, are interested in expanding the national diploma lines. WFF Foundation and the Committee of protected areas provides all the necessary approvals for the national reference, complete solutions of national award program managers of protected areas and would be happy to work with interested organizations and clubs, as well as with individual radio amateurs. If you have the desire and ability to create and establishment of a national award program of specially protected natural areas in the country, should send an application to the WFF Committee of protected areas.

**WFF GLOBE General** - Activator - for more than 100 different WFF expeditions / references, on 6 continents (each continent can be replaced by five different references WFF).

## 16 WFF database

Ham radio operators, who worked previously in protected areas and wishing to participate in the program WFF, must send in a log to the WFF Committee of protected areas, to make a credit WFF program and introduction to the WFF Database, information about the activity period of the original QSL (preferably with specifying the control number and the name of WFF Specially protected natural area, various kinds of materials, photo / video report, an article in any form, etc., or a photocopy of the media source.

### 16.2 **To achieve the WFF diplomas and awards**

16.2.1 The applicant must have a license to operate an amateur radio station, or be a SWL.

16.2.2 Counted QSO / SWL with the protected areas on the list of program WFF.

16.2.3 Each WFF reference counted only once regardless of the range and type of radiation. If you prefer, you can specify in the application specific type of radiation, or a range and it will be printed on the diploma or award. Non-through certificates for each class and category separately. For certain types of radiation or a separate numbering range is not maintained. Do not count QSO, carried out with different bands (cross-band) and communications via terrestrial repeaters.

16.2.4 All QSO can be made by the applicant of one or more countries with callsign / callsigns personally issued to the applicant's telecommunications administration.

16.2.5 Counted QSO, made on any HF or VHF bands, different types of modulation, without time limits.

16.2.6 In order to be counted activators of the expedition, in which they took a direct part (individually or in teams), while for each period of activity from this area should be held not less than 44 links to various correspondents. "

### 16.3 **Making an application for WFF diplomas and awards**

16.3.1 For the convenience of making application for the WFF diplomas and awards in digital form can be downloaded from the site. It is proposed to your attention an example of making an application for WFF diplomas and awards. Name of protected area to write a QSL or as a WFF Directory.

16.3.2 You not to waste your money and time, including the head of the WFF and WFF program graduate of the Committee, before drawing up an application consult with WFF Directory.

16.3.3 Call in the Application the way it is written on the QSL.

- 16.3.4 You can include in the application more QSO / SWL with the protected areas for WFF diplomas or awards. In the future, when you make these QSO / SWL, it will be considered for a possible subsequent receipt of WFF diplomas or awards and achievements in the results.
- 16.3.5 Upon receipt of WFF regular diplomas or awards, the application must specify only the new QSO / SWL, applying only to new QSL request (scans or photocopies acceptable), and data systems LoTW ARRL and eQSL.
- 16.4 **Consideration of WFF table of top-44 achievements**
- 16.4.1 On the basis of applications received from members WFF program for hunters and activator is TOP-progress table 44.
- 16.4.2 Hunters can update the results without sending an application for a diploma. Application is made as well as in degree, and also attach scans or photocopies of QSL), these systems LoTW ARRL, E-QSL or through Green Log Search.
- 16.4.3 Claimed QSO / SWL in the future you can use when receiving WFF diplomas and awards, without having to send scans or photocopies of QSL.
- 16.4.4 To receive confirmation of your application on WFF diplomas and awards, including for economic purposes, it is recommended to send scans or photocopies of QSL, but at the head of the WFF program is the right to request any of the original QSL.
- 16.5 **WFF honor roll**
- 16.5.1 Holders of WFF HR Plaque will be included in the list of WFF Honor Roll.
- 16.5.2 Holders of awards WFF GLOBE will be included in the list of Green Hall of Fame.
- 16.5.3 List of WFF Honor Roll is published every quarter (April 1, July 1, October 1, and January 1).
- 16.5.4 Lists are maintained separately in 3 categories: hunters, activators and SWL.
- 17 Green annual nomination**
- 17.1 WFF Foundation with the assistance of the Committee as an incentive and motivation activities under the program performs the following WFF Green Annual Nomination, starting with 1.01. 2011:
- WFF TOP-44: Ratings of hunters, activators, and observers;
  - "The World Scout of the Year";
  - «WFF expedition of the year" - continental tests;
  - "Best WFF expedition of the year".
- 17.2 Hams, who participated in the WFF expedition, in the preparation of applications for certificates or awards WFF has the right to include this activity in the personal credit. This requires that its call sign is printed on the QSL, provided with the application or its participation is confirmed by the WFF expedition.
